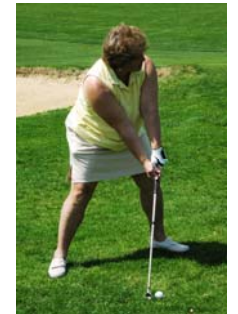

Clinics

We have designed a variety of clinics to meet the needs of all levels of golfers. Clinics are taught by either Rebecca Dengler, PGA/LPGA Teaching Professional, or Eric MacCluen, PGA Professional.

Get Ready...Golf – A Beginner Program

Offered by Becky Dengler, this is a 5 week program consisting of 1 hour classes to show new players all aspects of the game. The class will meet on Thursday evenings from 6–7 p.m. at Ed “Porky” Oliver Golf Club. The fifth week of each session will meet from 6-8 pm. The fee is \$110 for members and \$135 for non-members.

Session 1: April 16, 23, 30, May 7, 14

Session 2: June 4, 11, 18, 25, July 2

Novice Golfer Program

Offered by Becky Dengler, this is a 4 week program consisting of 1½ hour classes and is for those golfers who currently play the game. This program will allow players to develop all aspects of the game from short game to swing to on-course play. The class will meet on Tuesday evenings from 6-7:30 p.m. at Ed “Porky” Oliver Golf Club. The fee is \$110 for members and \$135 for non-members.

Session 1: April 21, 28, May 5, 12

Session 2: May 26, June 2, 9 and 16

Session 3: July 7, 14, 21, 28

Breaking 100

Offered by Becky Dengler, this 2 hour class is for those golfers who would like to develop their game to shoot under 100. The class will look at specific areas and skills needed by each player to break this barrier. Players are encouraged to attend this program as much as desired to continue to develop these skills throughout the season. The class will meet on Saturdays from 2-4 p.m. at Ed “Porky” Oliver Golf Club. Members pay only \$50 per session or \$175 for all four sessions. Non-members pay \$65 per session or \$225 for all four sessions. Program dates are April 25, May 30, June 27, and July 18.

Clinics (cont.)

Pitch and Wine

Offered by Becky Dengler, this 1½ hour class will assist golfers in tightening up their short game. The clinic will focus on improving shots from 30 yards and in. Players are encouraged to attend both sessions to continue to develop these skills throughout the season. The class will meet on Fridays from 5:30-7:00 p.m. at Ed “Porky” Oliver Golf Club with a social hour following. The fee for this program is \$40 for members and \$50 for non-members per session. Cost includes clinic only. Program dates are April 17 and May 15.

On Course Instruction

Offered by Eric MacCluen, these sessions will provide you with the opportunity to practice hitting the ball out of tough situations on the course. Multiple situations will be provided while playing up to 9 holes during each session. Following instruction, the course will remain open for you to continue playing. Sessions will take place at Chisel Creek Golf Club beginning at 4 p.m. on April 26, May 2, May 23, July 12 and August 16. The fee is \$45 for members per session. Bring a non-member and your price will be reduced to \$40. Sessions will also take place at Honeybrook Golf Club beginning at 4:30 p.m. on May 3, May 31 and June 28. Light beverages and snacks will be provided following the Honeybrook sessions. The fee is \$60 for members per session. Bring a non-member and your price will be reduced to \$55.

Friday Night Outings

Offered by Eric MacCluen, these outings are similar to the Friday Scrambles held at Ed “Porky” Oliver Golf Club but are instead held at Chisel Creek Golf Club. The evening begins with a clinic that will provide an opportunity to work in different aspects of the game which can then be reinforced on the course. Sessions will be held on Friday nights from 6-8 p.m. on June 19 and July 31. The fee is \$40 for members. Bring a non-member and your price will be reduced to \$35.

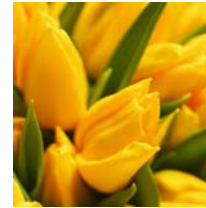
Refund Policy

*Golf Course Designations

The Chapter rates the degree of difficulty of the golf courses it plays using the same system that ski resorts use to rate the difficulty of their trails. A green circle means the course is beginner-friendly. A blue square means the course has an intermediate level of difficulty. A black diamond means the course is extremely challenging with many hazards and/or blind shots. We hope that this system will assist members in determining what courses are suited to their level of play.

Golf Outing Formats

Best Two of Four: Four person team; each team member plays her own ball and the two best scores of the foursome, adjusted with handicap, are recorded as the team score.

Better Ball of Partners: Two person team; each golfer plays her own ball and the best score of the pair, adjusted with handicap, is recorded as the team's score.

Florida Scramble: Four person team; on par 3 holes, each team member plays her own ball for the entire hole; on par 4 holes, each team member tees off, the best drive is selected and then each team member plays her own ball for the remainder of the hole; on par 5 holes, each team member tees off and the best drive is selected. Each team member hits a second shot and the best second shot is selected. From this point forward, each team member plays her own ball for the remainder of the hole. The best individual score on each hole, adjusted with handicap, is recorded as the team's score.

Individual Stroke Play: It's you against the course. Handicaps are required to play in this format.

Ka-Ching: Four person team; each team member plays her own ball and earns or loses points for the team based on a variety of options (e.g., earn 1 point for a par; lose 2 points for a ball in the water, etc.). The team with the highest positive point score is the winner.

Scramble: Four person team; each team member tees off and the best drive is selected. Each team member hits a second shot and the best second shot is selected. This procedure is continued until the ball is holed out. A team score is recorded on the scorecard.

Shamble: Four person team; each team members tees off and the best drive is selected. Everyone then plays their own ball for the remainder of the hole. The best score or the two best scores, depending on format, are recorded as the team's score.

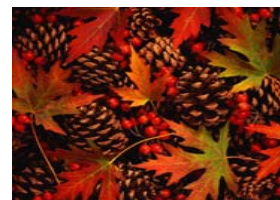

Open Play Nights

Open play nights provide opportunities for members and their guests to gather and play nine holes after work.

On Mondays beginning April 6, we will be meeting at Delcastle Golf Club between 4:45 and 5:45 p.m.. Simply call the pro shop the week before and request a tee time with the EWGA group.

On Tuesdays beginning April 14, we will be meeting at Rock Manor Golf Club between 4:30 and 5:00 p.m. Again, simply call the pro shop the week before and request a tee time with the EWGA group.

Leagues

Interested in a little friendly team competition? If so, our match play leagues are for you. There will be two leagues this season — one at Delcastle and one at Rock Manor. You may play in one or both leagues but you must have an established handicap to play. The leagues will be comprised of three or four person teams assembled by the league committee following the close of registration. Each team will have a captain who will work with her team to determine which players will play in each match. Every team must provide two members to play on each of the match dates, and every team member must play in at least four matches during the season. Depending on the outcome, a playoff in late September or early October may be necessary to determine the winning team. Prizes will be awarded.

Match dates for Delcastle: 5/18, 6/1, 6/15, 6/29, 7/13, 7/27, 8/10, 8/24, 9/14 and 9/21. Deadline to register: April 27.

Match dates for Rock Manor: 5/12, 5/26, 6/9, 6/23, 7/7, 7/21, 8/4, 8/18, 9/1 and 9/15. Deadline to register : April 28.

Handicap Information

If you are a new or occasional golfer, you may think that getting a handicap isn't something for you. We encourage all EWGA members to start a handicap now. A free handicap service called "Golf Life Management System" (GLMS) is available to you online through the EWGA website as part of your membership.

Starting a handicap early in your golf experience has several benefits:

- It is a good way to track progress in your golf game. The handicap system takes into account differences in golf courses through the slope and rating assigned to each golf course (and set of tees at the same golf course). Watching the trend of your golf index through the year can let you know if you are getting better or staying the same.
- You will be prepared when you decide to play in an EWGA golf outing or league or are invited to participate in a Member-Guest or a charity tournament. Most golf events require a handicap. By having your handicap already established, you will avoid the last minute panic of trying to find enough score cards with your scores to establish a handicap to allow you to play in an event.

Information on GLMS can be found in the Members Only section of the EWGA website at www.ewga.com. Once you log into the Members Only section, click on "Communities" and then go into the Document Archive section of "Leadership Links." There, you will find a folder titled "Handicaps" which contains the user's manual for GLMS. The manual is also available on the Wilmington Chapter website at www.ewgade.com/contact.html.

Event dates are June 12, July 17, August 7 and September 11.

This multi-skill challenge will put your golf skills to the test. Players will be competing in putting, pitching, 100-yard accuracy and on-course challenges. The event will be held on Saturday, October 3 at Ed "Porky" Oliver Golf Club from 1-4 pm. The fee is \$50 for members and \$60 for non-members.

Second Annual Chapter Pro-Am

Join Becky Dengler and Cathy Reynolds for a fun day of golf, food and drink at our second annual Chapter Pro Am to be scheduled in September or October at a great area golf course.

EWGA Championship Series

The EWGA Championship is the largest, organized, women's amateur golf competition in the world! Members of all skill levels, provided you have a USGA handicap, are encouraged to compete.

There are three stages to the Championship: (1) one 18-hole qualifying event at the local Chapter level; (2) one 18-hole District Semi-Final Championship held at 15 venues across the Association; and (3) a two-day 36-hole Championship Final.

By design, the Championship offers two different competitive formats: stroke play and inter-chapter team scramble. You select the competitive format that best fits your game, personality and skill level.

Stroke Play Competition: Competitors are flighted in five flights at the Chapter Championship qualifying event based upon their handicap index and remain in that flight throughout the Championship. The EWGA Championship is conducted with both low gross and low net winners in each flight.

Inter-Chapter Team Scramble: If teamwork and teambuilding are your strengths, this may be the format for you. This format consists of a four-woman team, comprised of your Chapter friends and fellow golfers who meet the eligibility requirements to play in the scramble format.

The schedule for this year's Championship for the Wilmington Chapter is:

Chapter Championship: June 14, 2009, Pikeek Creek Golf Club, Wilmington, Delaware.

Semi-Finals: August 8, 2009, Hershey Golf Links, Hummelstown, Pennsylvania.

Finals: September 25-26, 2009, The PGA Golf Club, Port St. Lucie, Florida.
